### TICKETING

Please ensure you print out your tickets or have them available to display on your smart phone at the entry gate. Children 12 years and under will require a child ticket for entry and must be accompanied by an adult. If you need to leave the event site once gates are open you will need to obtain a pass out stamp. Entry will not be allowed without a valid ticket.

### FOOD AND DRINK

There will be a variety of food vendors selling food at this event. Water and non-alcoholic drinks will also be available. You are welcome to bring your own picnic but we encourage you to try some of the delicious food options available. An ATM will be available on site. This is an alcohol and smoke free event. Bags will be checked upon entry.

### GETTING THERE AND BACK

There will be designated parking areas on site at Paloma South (CP1), Shelvock (CP2) and John Maloney West Parks (CP3). We anticipate car parks will fill quickly so consider car-pooling or catching public transport. Please follow the directions of all parking marshals and do not park outside the areas indicated or on the street verge.

Patrolling rangers may issue infringements for vehicles causing an obstruction. Overflow car parking will be available at Alexander Heights Shopping Centre.

There will be a shuttle bus service running free of charge from CP2 and CP3. When waiting for the shuttle please assemble at the designated points only.

CP1 - Paloma Park South

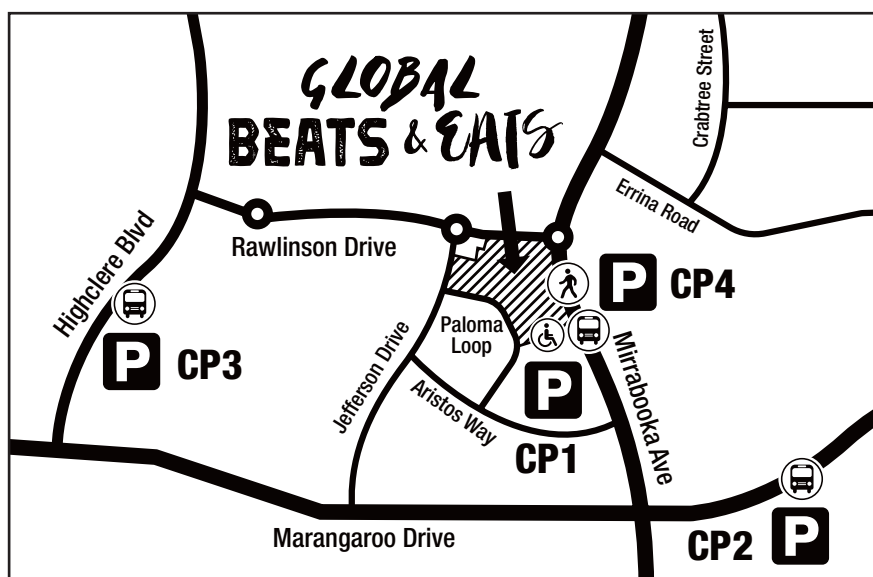
CP2 - Shelvock Park

## ENTRY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please do not attempt to breach these entry terms as admission will be refused.

### SECURITY AND BAG CHECKS

Prior to entry we are required to execute a full search of your accompanying bags, to ensure you are not in possession of alcohol or other prohibited items.

### ALCOHOL

Strictly no alcohol can be brought into the venue. If you arrive intoxicated you will be refused entry.

### ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

Security and event management reserve the right to refuse admission or to eject a patron for behaviour likely to cause damage, injury, nuisance or annoyance or for failure to comply with reasonable requests.

Intoxication, aggressive or anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated. Any person who behaves in this manner will be removed or referred to the Police.

### NO GLASS

This includes drink bottles and glasses, jars, or any other containers or items made of glass.

### NO METAL CUTLERY

All metal cutlery is strictly forbidden to be brought into the venue, this includes cheese knives. Disposable wooden and plastic cutlery is permitted.

### SEATING

You are welcome to bring a small picnic rug and / or fold up camping chairs. There will be designated 'seating' areas for picnic rugs and low back chairs.

Please be mindful not to block the views of others around you. Tents, large items of furniture and inflatable furniture are prohibited at this event.

### PHOTOGRAPHY

As a condition of entry, you accept that photographs and video footage of you in the crowd may be used for future marketing purposes.

If you do not want your photo taken, you must notify one of the City of Wanneroo Event Staff.

### SMOKING

This is a smoke-free event. There will be a designated smoking area outside of the venue. Smoking is not permitted in any other area.

### CAMERAS AND RECORDING DEVICES

Professional recording or photography equipment (including drones) will not be permitted at this event, unless you have media and professional photographer accreditation arranged with the City of Wanneroo prior to the event.

Recording of stage performances using audio, video or photographic equipment is not permitted.

Unauthorised or prohibited photography may result in images being deleted by security staff. It is at security's discretion to deem your camera professional and debate will not be entered into.

Cameras with powerful zoom lenses or multiple lenses in a carry case are not allowed. Permission is at the discretion of the City.

### WEATHER

If it rains, the show will go on. The show will only be abandoned if conditions are deemed dangerous.

### UMBRELLAS

All umbrellas are strictly forbidden at the event.

### ANIMALS

Pets or animals of any kind will not be permitted to enter the event site (excluding guide dogs and police and emergency service dogs).

### OTHER

Occasionally changes to the line-up or program times occur that are out of Event Management's control. Management reserves the right to change the line-up and/or the date of the event without prior notification.
